<p>RWInc <u>Set 2 Spellings</u> or speed sounds from 9:30. Then choose a RWInc ebook on Oxford Owl to read this week.</p>	<p>Make some sports equipment even better, like Mrs Armitage does... perhaps a scooter could have a built-in jet pack, and a snack pocket! You could make your design with fabrics, junk modelling or old plastic bags! Write about your design.</p>	<p>Practise your maths facts: number bonds, doubles or halves. E.g. What is half of ten? What is double 4? What goes with 8 to make 10? What goes with 3 to make 5? Answer quick questions or play Hit the Button.</p>	<p>Try some of the PE challenges here: https://www.youthsporttrust.org/pe-home-learning - there are instruction cards and some videos to watch to learn how to do the tasks. Let me know which one is your favourite, on Evidence Me.</p>
<p>Phonics play website Dragons Den game – choose ‘igh’ or ‘air’ from phase 3. Homepage explains how to log in for free.</p>	<p>Sentence: practise writing ‘air’. The girl sat on a chair. Hot challenge: what colour is the chair? Add ‘and’ to tell me what sport the girl did next.</p>	<p>Shapes that roll. What 3D objects can you find that roll well? Perhaps a ball, water bottle, toilet roll, ice cream cone wafer. Notice that they need to have a curved face. Can you remember the names? Sphere, Cylinder, Cone. What rolls the fastest, using a slope and a timer?</p>	<p>Healthy snacks – sportspeople make sure they can perform at their best by eating lots of healthy food that gives them energy and makes them strong. Can you plan and make a healthy snack? Perhaps you could make some fruit kebabs, or a yoghurt and fruit smoothie.</p>
<p>Wonder words in this pack – can you read the sentences and decide which ones are ‘yes’ and which ones are ‘no’.</p>	<p>Obstacle course instructions: make an obstacle course and write what to do for each part: start, jump, twirl, kick. If you have some chalk, you could write these instructions onto the ground!</p>	<p>Shapes that stack. What 3D objects can you find to build a tower with? Cereal boxes, toy blocks, Jenga and dice. Can you remember the names? Cube or cuboid, and cylinders. We can put cones or pyramids on the top, but we need flat faces on the top and the bottom to build towers. Create a construction item with the stackable 3D shapes you have found, with flat faces.</p>	<p>Make an obstacle course and time how long it takes to complete, e.g. with a timer on a phone. Fit in as many sports moves as you can think off: throwing, catching, dribbling a ball, jumping, skipping. Balance a ball on a tennis racquet or plate: can you walk still enough that the ball doesn’t fall off? Try it in both hands – is it more challenging in the other hand?</p>
<p>Try one of the ‘read and draw’ comprehension tasks below. Read them carefully.</p>	<p>Handwriting: write out your first name and last name lots of times. Think about which letters are taller and which go under the line to keep it neat. You could look at the letters on Sky Writer to check how to form them.</p>	<p>Shape Names – Practise 3D shape names with this song or the sheet in this pack. Put a 3D shaped item from around the house in a bag for your child to feel and guess what shape it is, or they could give you clues for you to guess e.g. it has a point, and a curved face, and a flat round face... a cone!</p>	<p>Make a junk modelling football game. Using a lid of a shoe box or similar container, help your child to cut out two holes as the goals. Using something ball-like (e.g. a sweet), take turns aiming at your partner’s goal whilst the other tries to save the goal!</p> 
<p>RWInc <u>red words session 1</u> daily session from 9:30 to practise reading red words</p>	<p>Draw yourself doing your favourite sport and write sentences about your picture using your phonics. E.g. <i>I can jump with 2 feet.. I can hop 30 tighms.</i></p>	<p>Numbots - Use your login details. How many coins have you earned? Can you complete the iron and tin levels to unlock the challenge? You could ask someone at home to help press the buttons if this is tricky to do quickly.</p>	<p>Dress up for some sports – Joe Wicks usually dresses up for his Friday PE session. You could dress up as an animal and make up a dance where you move like that animal, or for a themed cosmic yoga session. Or try the sports colouring below.</p>

We keep socks in pairs.

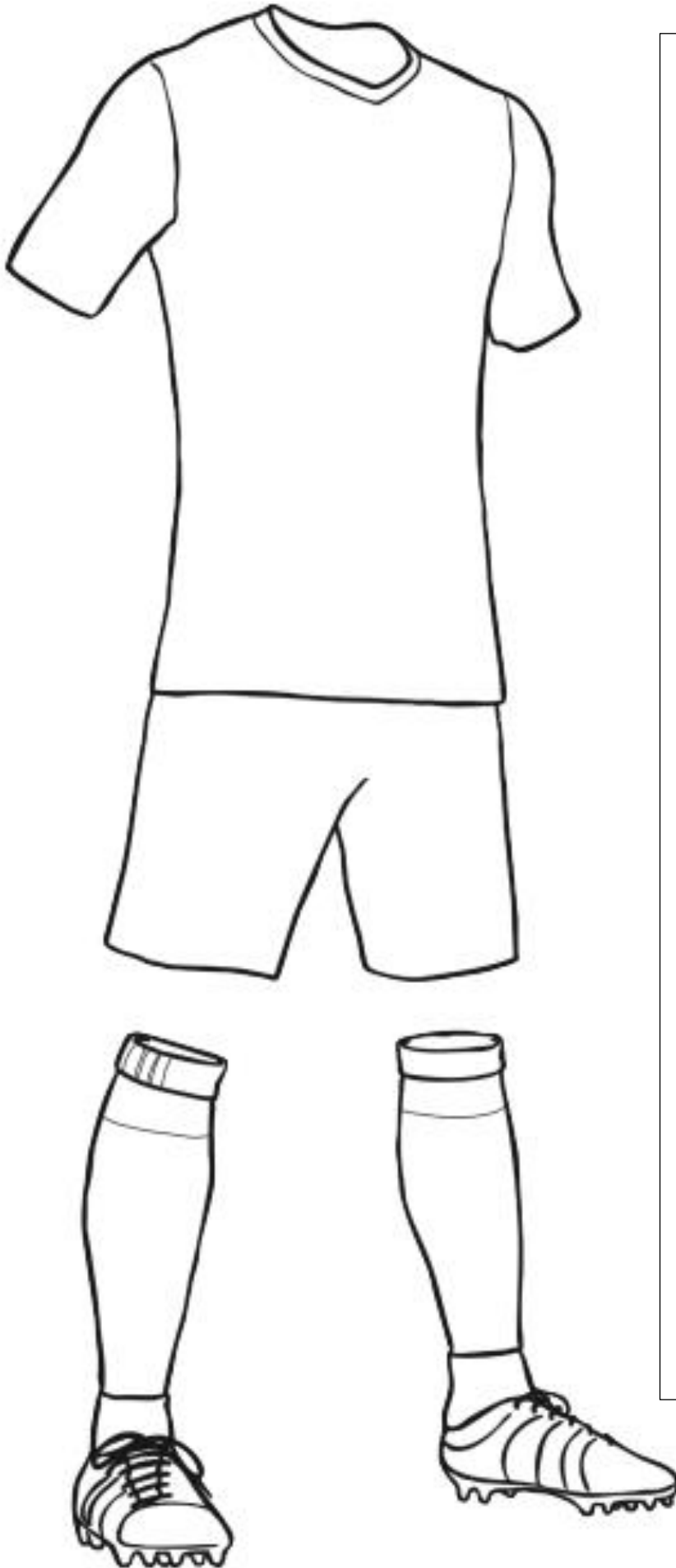
Cats like to sit in chairs.

The football has black hexagons on it.

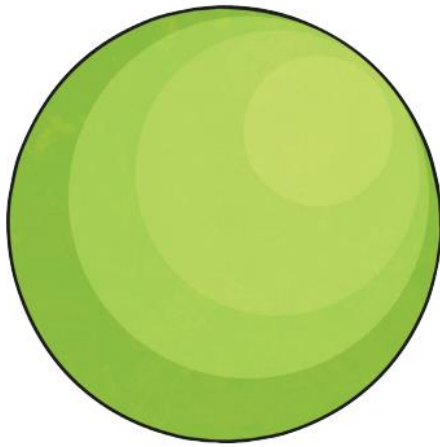
The girl has light yellow hair and a green shirt. Her shorts are black and her socks are green. Her boots are dark green too!

The boy has a red shirt and dark red shorts. His socks are black and his boots are green. His hair is black.

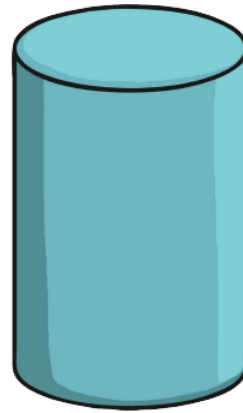
I think the girl will win! She is running very quickly.

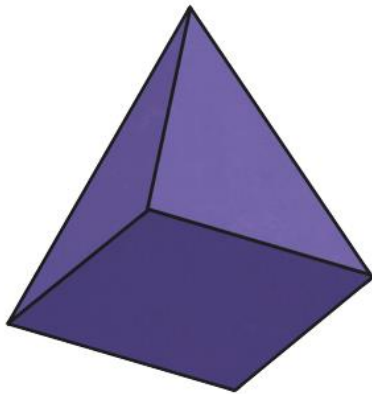
Sphere



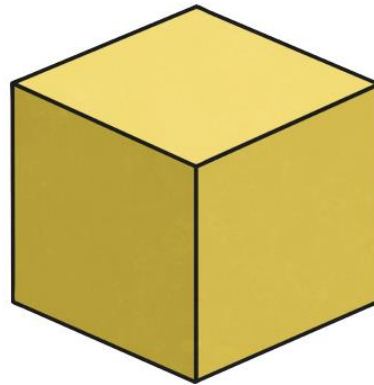
Cylinder



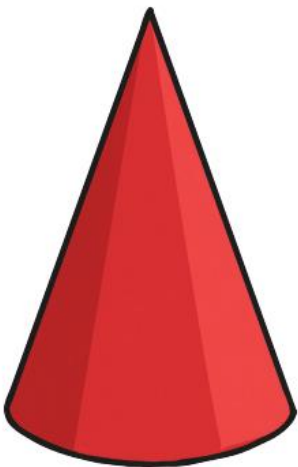
Pyramid



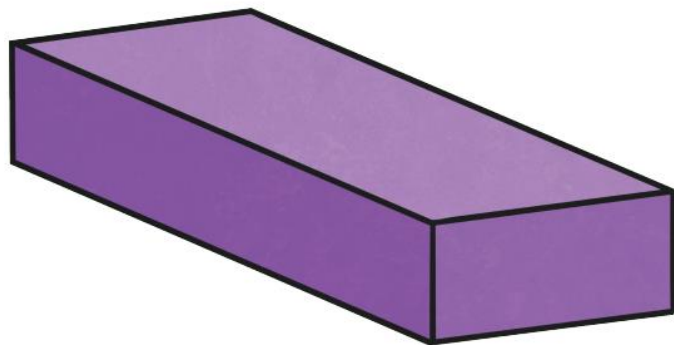

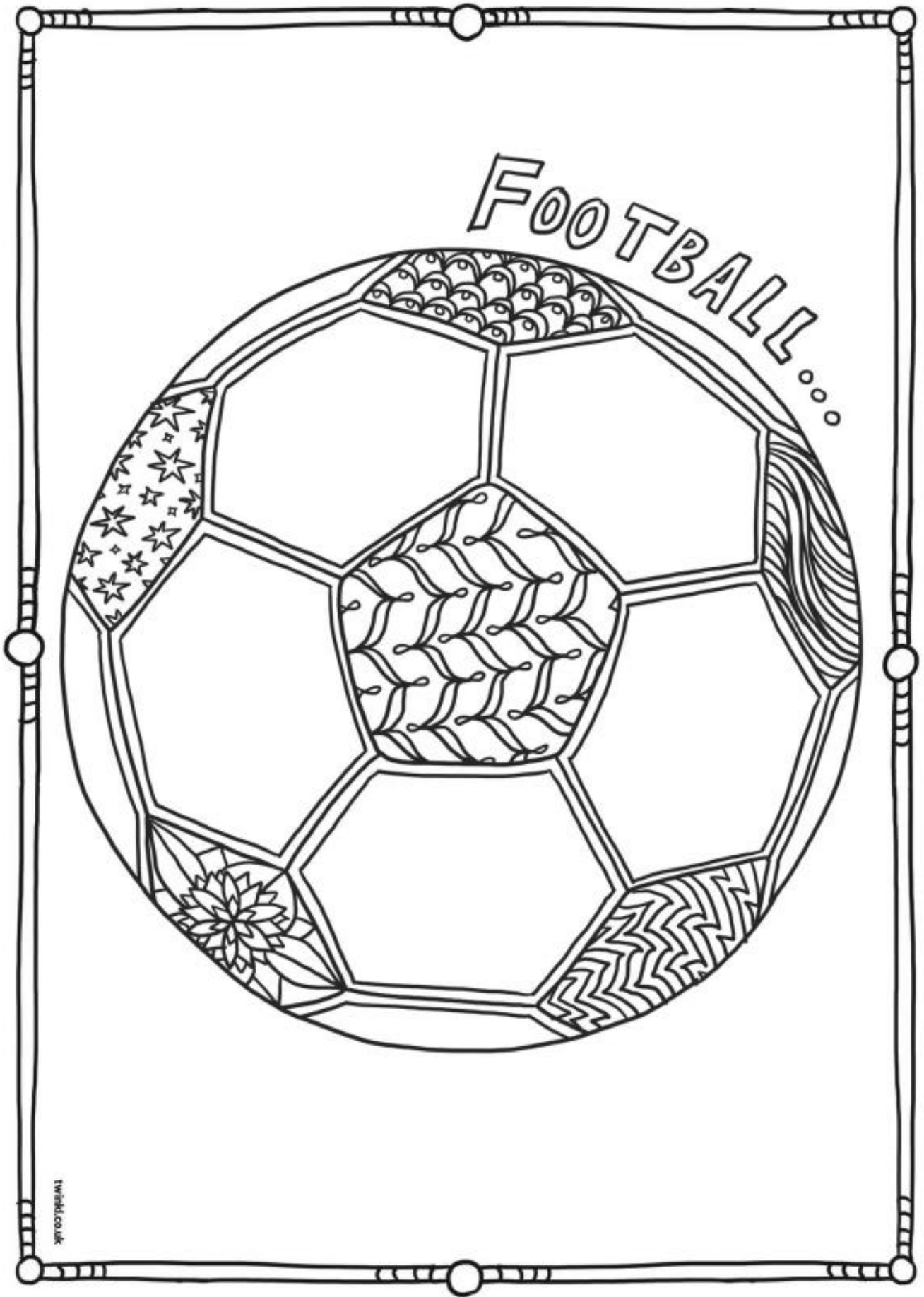

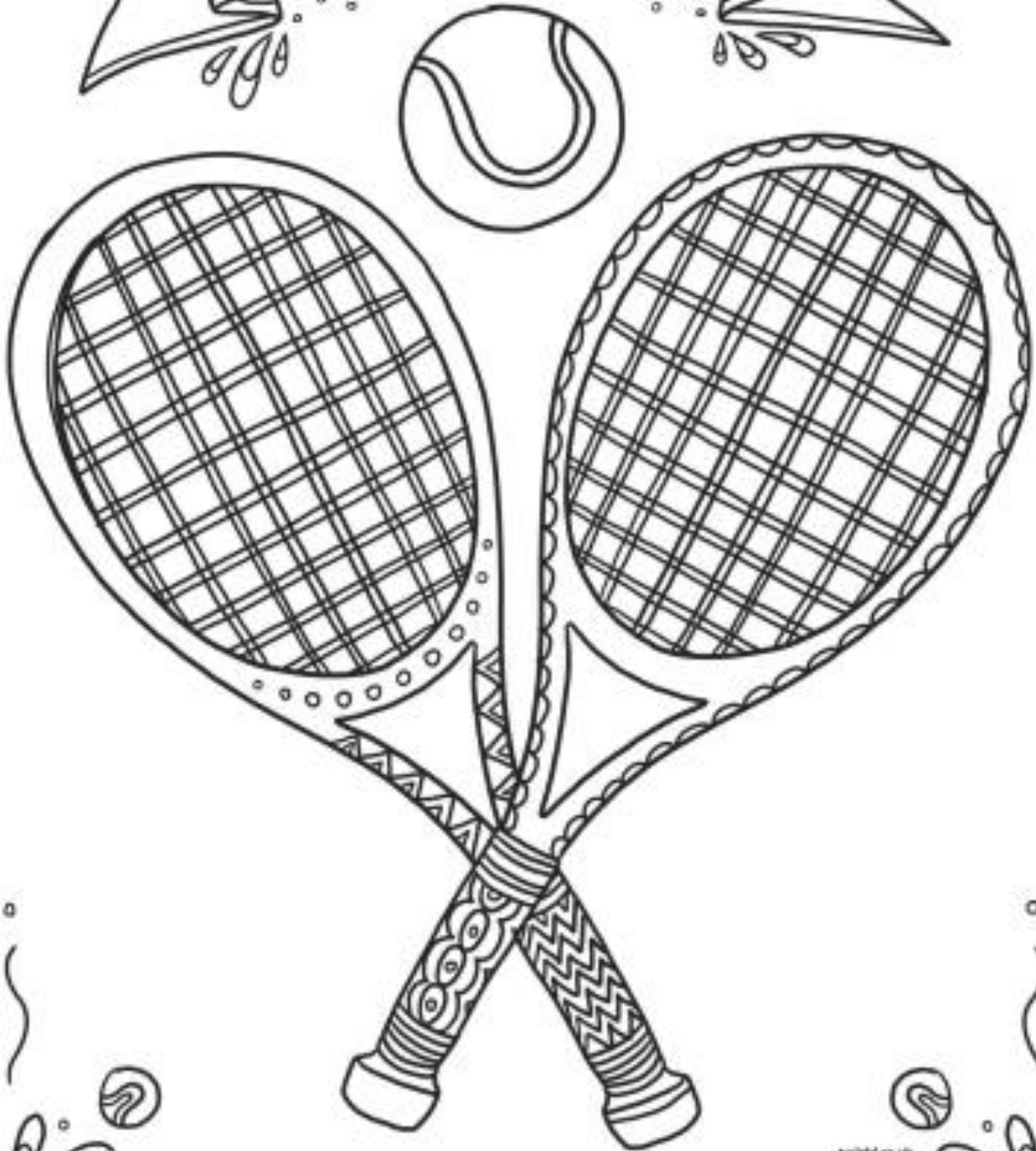
