Cammunication Language and Literacy

Through these texts we plan to write descriptive words and captions, follow instructions, create a class poem and engage in drana. Our daily phonics sessions will continue and as discussed at parents evening the children will most be in smaller groups, We will also start show and tell this term and a rota will go up on the noticeboard with the week your child can talk about or bring in a small object related to our trojic from home.
